





Northwest Suburban Quilters Guild (NSQG) is excited to welcome **Judy Gauthier** as our guest lecturer and instructor in March, 2019. Judy has a passion for modern, scrappy quilting. In 2011 she opened her quilt shop, Bungalow Quilting and Yarn in Ripon, Wisconsin. Her shop features mostly modern, bright, contemporary fabrics and yarns. Over the years she has developed templates to help her manage the scraps and she has written two books on how to use her templates to turn a quilter's stash into stunning quilts. Guests are welcome to join us at our guild meeting on **Thursday March 21, 2019** for Judy's lecture and trunk show, "**Quilting for Scrap Lovers – Using Your Stash**", in which Judy will talk about her own journey for using up her scrap pile and turning those scraps into stunning quilts.

Our meetings are held at the **Rolling Meadows Community Center Auditorium**, 3705 Pheasant Drive, Rolling Meadows, IL 60008. The guest fee is \$10. Doors open at 6:30 p.m. and the meeting will begin at 7:15 p.m.

On **Friday, March 22, 2019**, Judy will teach her class "**Blended Hexagons**". In this class you'll learn Judy's special technique for making this hexagon quilt. Pull out your scraps and blend like-colors together. You'll be amazed at how quickly you'll cut through your scraps and how fast this quilt is made! (Photos of Judy's sample is above.)

There are openings in Judy's class at this time; non-members will pay the same fee as our members for this class: \$45 + block template set (Simple Square Templates Fast2Cut from C&T Publishing, available from Judy on the day of the class).
